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Lesson 17: Communicating with Animals that Have Passed

Watch the video and understand that telepathic connection knows no boundaries. That means unlike the physical world of solid material and “here and there” or life and death, telepathy connects and moves through the illusion of earth. I, too wondered, “Is this possible?” She gave me the dog’s name and breed. Calling on the dog I was able to clearly describe the home she lived in at that time, her son and a medical condition he had and the painful issue surrounding the death of this dog. What the woman most needed, and the dog offered was, “I forgive you.” The woman broke down into sobs.

You too can connect with your animals that have passed. Whether it’s been a few weeks, months or forty years, your animal’s soul is willing and able to share a connection with you.

Use any of these items to start a connection with your animal:

1. A picture
2. Fur
3. Their collar

4. Ashes
5. Paper with their name written on it

Tip:

Remember to write down ahead of time, any questions you might have for your companion on the other side. Sometimes you might become very emotional and forget your questions. Have them written down and in front of you. You might not get to all of them or even any of them the first time, but if you need them you are all set.

Questions:

What happened when you called on your animal that had passed?

What questions did you ask?

What kind of response(s) did you receive?

How do you feel after this opportunity to connect with your pet that transitioned?

How will your life be different now?
